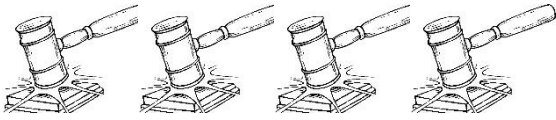

Alex Reed, Secretary

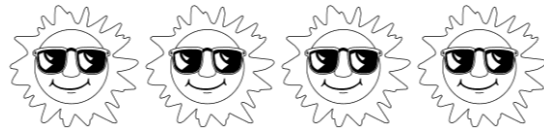
Alex will take the lead on communications, including the newsletter. Her email is secretary@forestbrookhoa.org

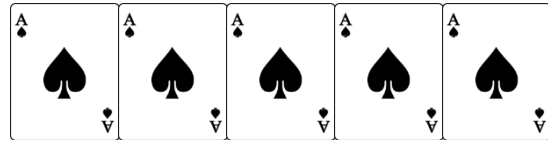
Tennis Update
